Patrascioiu of Curl, Glasson & Patrascioiu, P.L.C.) - PERSONAL INJURY -Plntf, female, age 72, a retired REAREND. operating a 2011 Lexus, accountant, was travelling eastbound on Grant Road. Plntf alleged that, as she neared the intersection with Craycroft Road, she was rear-ended by Dfnt, who was operating a 2000 Subaru. Dfnt, male, age 34, an appliance technician, argued liability and causation. Plntf alleged she sustained cervical, thoracic, and lumbar soft tissue injuries; plus injuries to the left hand and knee; as well as emotional trauma. Dfnt argued Plntf was not injured, and her complaints were related to her preexistent condition. Dfnt called Frederick T. Strobl, M.D., a neurologist. Praver: Just and reasonable compensatory damages; plus \$6,058.10 medical expenses. Plntf's spouse made claim for loss of consortium. (Carrier: State Farm Insurance.) Dfnt made a \$14,900 pretrial offer of judgment; Dfnt made a \$100 pretrial offer of judgment to Plntf's spouse for loss of During closing arguments, Plntf's consortium. counsel asked jury to award Plntf \$30,000 to \$50,000, and award Plntf's spouse \$5,000 to \$10,000 for loss of consortium. Defense counsel argued liability and causation. Three day trial. Jury out less than one hour. FOUND FOR DFNT. UNANIMOUSLY.
